POSSIBLE RED FLAGS OF RESEARCH MISCONDUCT



- Usable data are only generated when there is a pressing deadline
- Experiments are completed faster than usual

RESULTS

- Data are too good to be true
- Findings can't be replicated by others in the lab



LACK OF TRANSPARENCY

- Raw data can't be produced when requested
- Research materials and protocols are kept hidden
- Work is mostly done when no one else is around
